**Simon Hunt** was born in Zimbabwe and raised in England and the United States. He is an instructor in English at Santa Catalina School in Monterey and has been a Tor House docent for eight years. He co-edited *Renaissance Culture and the Everyday* (University of Pennsylvania Press, 1999) and contributed an essay to that volume. His poems, primarily formal, have appeared (or are forthcoming) in *Troubadour*, *Court Green*, *Light Quarterly*, and *The Sewanee Review*, among other publications, as well as in the on-line journals *14 by 14* and *The Chimaera*. Last Spring, he essayed a role in the premiere North American performance/recording of Peter Thabit Jones's verse drama, *The Boy and the Lion's Head*.

An east coast native currently residing in Monterey, **Kathryn Petruccelli** is a teacher of writing, a freelance writer, and a now-and-again radio interviewer around things literary. Various kinds of exile and borderlands intrigue her. A political bent causes her to lean in even closer. Kathryn's poetry and interviews have appeared in *The Anthology of Monterey Bay Poets*, *The Porter Gulch Review*, <http://www.literarymama.com>, <http://www.mamazine.com>, and others.
